

Laura and Suzie discussed CYF request for new TV'S for community room using funds that were designated to CYF. Finance has given approval. TV's are from before building project. Motion made to approve purchase of TV's. (Keith/Terri) No discussion. Approved. Laura and Suzie also requested approval to use funds from Laura's Cont Education ('24/'25), Suzie's Cont Education ('25) and Staff Travel Line (up to \$1400). Finance gave approval of use of funds. Motion made to approve. (Julie/Andrea) No discussion. Approved.

Regular Business:

-Financial Report - Sue

Finance approved moving \$15,000 from savings to checking. Sue stated that due to the increase in offerings for August so far, is going to wait to see how financials for the month plays out before transfers.

Accounts Payable Approval-Motion to approve (Deb/Jon) No discussion

- -July Council Minutes Approval-Motion to approve (Jon/Neil) No discussion Approved
- -Ministry Review-Julie was able to get another person added to alter guild. Andrea is going to talk with property to get clarification of what needed to be cleaned.

Old Business:

-CYF Funds Follow up-Deb states it was approved by TDF to combine moving Sutter memorial to the designated funds for Sutter. Will be one line item for CYF funds.

New Business:

- -Principal Party/Stewardship Update & Discussion-TTT, Life and growth, finance, and executive had a meeting on August 4th to start the process of planning a potential principal party and bigger stewardship project. Lots of discussion was had on the financial situation of the church and what can be done to address. Funds have been given by individuals to help with the Principal Party. Motion made to proceed with the Principal Party. (Julie/Keith). Discussion was had on who would be in charge of planning. Pastor Megan agreed to run the campaign. Members of council agreed to help her as needed. Approved. Also discussed how to give more financial updates to members of church.
- -Projector Update- Finance Committee gave go ahead to purchase. Was approved by the executive council and has been purchased.
- -TDF Rep Jon agreed to be representative from council.
- -Property Request Update- Property is requesting to widen the west entry approach. Estimate it to be less than \$2000. Decided to table until the next meeting.
- -Outreach Special Offering- Outreach Committee is in need of winter boots for the Winter Gear give away. Would like approval to pass a boot one Sunday and one Wednesday to collect funds to buy boots for give away. Motion to approve (Jon/Ben) No discussion. Approved
- -Sue brought to council's attention the credit card is not under church and was instead under administrator. Motion made to authorize Sue to set up a credit card under church. (Keith/Ben) No Discussion Approved. Also informed the council that capital improvements balance is currently \$7,000 and is supposed to add \$1,000 monthly until back up to \$12,000. Motion made to rescind adding funds to Capital Improvement until it hits \$12,000 and leave balance as is. (Jon/Andrea) No discussion. Approved.




